What's Happening in the New Addition

Overview

June will continue to see the building rise out of the ground. As the "skeleton" of the building (structural steel and concrete) is completed, the "skin" (exterior walls) will be installed. Once the areas are protected from the elements, then the interior framing, mechanical, electrical, and finishing work will be completed. Both North and South wings will continue to be worked on simultaneously.

North and South Wings

- The structural steel has now reached the 4th floor and the concrete floors are at the 3rd floor level.
- All elevator and stairwell shafts are under construction and continue to rise along with the floor levels.
- Construction has begun on the interior walls on the main floor with mechanical and electrical rough-ins being added.

Atrium

The steel roofing has been installed above the new Atrium, the exterior walls are being enclosed and the in-floor heating lines and floor topping is being installed. Once this area is completely enclosed, the interior finishes will begin.



Renovation Update

- **The Front Entrance** landscaping will be completed in **June**. There may still be minor fixes along the way but the area should look close to the finished product.
- **The Chapel** renovations will continue throughout **June**.
- **The Social Work offices** will be turned back to the owner by **June 9**.
- **The Rehab Areas and the main floor washrooms** (outside of Towne Centre) will open the **week of June 19**.
- **The Rec Area** renovations will start during the week of **June 19** once Rehab moves back and the Rec Area staff, equipment, and items are removed. The work is expected to last the duration of the summer and the Hair Salon operations will *not* be impacted. The Rec Area renovations will include new flooring, millwork, lighting, ceiling and paint along with a Cultural Display Area and Gift Shop. Staff will be temporarily relocated to the boardroom during this time.
